that may be of use to you.


Some of them cost, some are free and some are subscription based.

Squeebles app bundle

App bundle £20.99. Can be bought seperately.

This bundle includes both maths and spelling apps. The Spelling app has inbuilt spelling lists but can also have you input your child's own spelling lists. The same for the wordsearch app. This is a fantastic way for children to engage in spelling practise before our tests in school.






Reading Eggs

Reading eggs offers a wide range of mini lessons, games and interactive activities. It has phonics, reading comprehension and maths incorporated on and is great for children from 2-11yrs. See their website for more info. This is subscription based.

Numbots

From the same developers as TTRS, numbots is all about addition and subtraction and the solid understanding of number in various representations. It works similar to TTRS, except these are Robots and not Rockstars. A great engaging way to secure number, addition and subtraction. This is subscription based.
