
Spring Discos

We're also looking at introducing two new exciting roles which will enhance the PSA and our fundraising ability. Further information will be sent out in April





What are the PSA tunds spent on?

The PSA work closely with Mrs Carpenter and the wider school team to ensure all funds raised are spent on enhancing the children's learning, development and creativity within school.

Over the past few month the PSA have funded over £3000 of resources and activities. These include £200 worth of Year 5 and 6 Art resources, over £500 worth of whole school maths resources, £100 worth of EYFS Construction materials and over £250 of KS1 outdoor learning equipment

The PSA will once again be purchasing the Year 6 leavers hoodies with a cost in excess $\pounds750$

What are we tundraising tor next?

In the summer term the PSA are planning to meet with the school council to discuss what they would like to see the PSA funding being spent on.

Getting the children's perspective on what they feel your donations should be spent on is just as important as working with Mrs Carpenter and the wider school staff.

With the support of Mrs Carpenter we're hoping the children can bring some exciting new ideas for both fundraising activities as well as how the funds can be spent in the future.



Every year we're lucky to be able to make a difference to each of children's school experience but we couldn't do it without you.

Your donations and support allows us to go beyond the scope of the stretched school budgets, providing the children with the 'Little Extras' they wouldn't normally get.

As I'm sure you're all aware, planning, organising and hosting fundraising events take a lot of time and effort and this is all done by a small but dedicated team of volunteers

With another jam packed calendar of events and our first Summer Fayre post Covid, we're in desperate need of new PSA members. This will enable us to continue to support the school as a charitable partner going forward.
