What a year it has been!

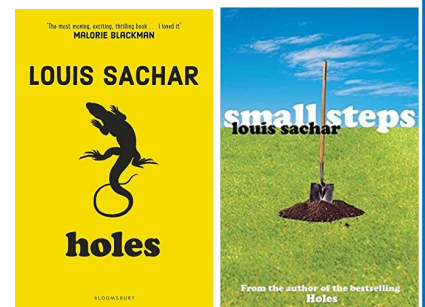
