




Clear Progression Through Reception

Levels 2 to 4




The Rhino Readers sublevels focus on GPCs and tricky words already taught in the Twinkl Phonics teaching weeks - allowing children to practise and embed recent learning as they develop fluency and understanding.

Each level reinforces all the focus graphemes and tricky words/CEWs from previous levels.
